GSMEC Board Restructuring Update

In our March 2019 Newsletter Layne Jennings explained the Upper Room recommended board restructuring for Emmaus communities that have multiple ministries. The Great Smoky Mountain Emmaus Board of Directors did approve the new structure. That started a 60 day window where the Emmaus Community could halt the process with 25 signatures on a petition. We did receive a valid petition with the required number of signatures on the last day. We believe the concern centers around the issue that the new structure may make it more difficult to find board and committee leaders each year.

The board will now listen to the concerns and recommendations of the petitioners and see if it is possible to modify the structure to alleviate the issue. That discussion may occur at this month's board meeting on June 8th.

We will keep you informed of our progress as discussions take place.
